1 November 2020 Solemnity of All Saints

Entrance Antiphon: Let us all rejoice in the Lord, as we celebrate the feast day in honour of all the Saints, at whose festival the Angels rejoice and praise the Son of God.

#### First Reading: A reading from the book of Apocalypse (7:2-4, 9-14)

I, John, saw another angel rising where the sun rises, carrying the seal of the living God; he called in a powerful voice to the four angels whose duty was to devastate land and sea, 'Wait before you do any damage on land or sea or to the trees, until we have put the seal on the foreheads of the servants of our God.' Then I heard how many were sealed: a hundred and forty-four thousand, out of all the tribes of Israel. After that I saw a huge number, impossible to count, of people from every nation, race, tribe and language; they were standing in front of the throne and in front of the Lamb, dressed in white robes and holding palms in their hands. They shouted aloud, 'Victory to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!' And all the angels who were standing in a circle round the throne surrounding the elders and the four animals, prostrated themselves before the throne, and touched the ground with their foreheads, worshipping God with these words, 'Amen. Praise and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honour and power and strength to our God for ever and ever. Amen.' One of the elders then spoke, and asked me, 'Do you know who these people are, dressed in white robes, and where they have come from?' I answered him, 'You can tell me, my Lord.' Then he said, 'These are the people who have been through the great persecution, and they have washed their robes white again in the blood of the Lamb."

#### Responsorial Psalm: (Ps. 23)

#### R. Lord, this is the people that longs to see your face.

- The Lord is the earth and its fullness, the world and all its peoples. It is he who set it on the seas; on the waters he made it firm. (R)
- Who shall climb the mountain of the Lord? Who shall stand in his holy place? The man with clean hands and pure heart, who desires not worthless things. (R)
- He shall receive blessings from the Lord and reward from the God who saves him. Such are the men who seek him, seek the face of the God of Jacob. (R)

#### Second Reading: A reading from the first letter of St John (3:1-3)

Think of the love that the Father has lavished on us, by letting us be called God's children; and that is what we are. Because the world refused to acknowledge him, therefore it does not acknowledge us. My dear people, we are already the children of God but what we are to be in the future has not yet been revealed, all we know is, that when it is revealed we shall be like him because we shall see him as he really is. Surely everyone who entertains this hope must purify himself, must try to be as pure as Christ.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia! Come to me, all you that labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest, says the Lord. Alleluia!

#### Gospel: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew (5:1-12)

Seeing the crowds, Jesus went up the hill. There he sat down and was joined by his disciples. Then he began to speak. This is what he taught them: 'How happy are the poor in spirit; theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Happy the gentle: they shall have the earth for their heritage; 'Happy those who mourn: they shall be comforted; Happy those who hunger and thirst for what is right: they shall be satisfied; 'Happy the merciful: they shall have mercy shown to them; Happy the pure in heart: they shall see God; 'Happy the peacemakers: they shall be called sons of God; Happy those who are persecuted in the cause of right: theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 'Happy are you when people abuse you and persecute you and speak all kinds of calumny against you on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven.'

**Memorial Acclamation:** Save us, Saviour of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

<u>Communion Antiphon</u>: Blessed are the clean of heart, for they shall see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God. Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.

The formal installation involves the making of the Profession of faith and the taking of the Oath of Fidelity in accordance with Canon Law. Let us all keep Fr Jean-Noël in our prayers as he embarks upon a new challenging chapter in his ministry at St Emilie's.

### The Role of the Parish Priest

Every Diocese is divided into distinct parts which are known as Parishes. A Parish is a community of Christ's faithful whose pastoral care is entrusted to a Parish Priest. He is the proper pastor of the community, caring for the people and celebrating the Sacraments. In the exercise of his office the Parish Priest acts under the authority of the diocesan Bishop.

The Parish Priest has a twofold obligation: to proclaim the Gospel and work toward the salvation of souls. In the fulfilment of these duties he is to involve the entire Parish community.

In summary we could say that he is involved in the following areas, either directly or indirectly:

- proclamation of the Word of God, through preaching, teaching, catechesis and the promotion of Catholic education
- leading people in worship through the liturgy
- · leadership and service of the Parish community
- seeing to the administration of temporal goods
- promotion of mission, outreach and support
- · promotion of social justice

Parish pastoral councils and parish finance committees enjoy a consultative role only. They are not executive bodies and cannot in any way become deliberative structures. Only those faithful who possess the qualities prescribed by the canonical norms may be elected to such responsibilities.

The Parish Priest presides at the pastoral and finance councils (though he can appoint a person to chair the meeting). Any deliberations entered into, (or decisions taken), by a pastoral or finance council which has not been presided over by the Parish Priest or which has assembled contrary to his wishes are to be considered as null and void.

As can be seen, the role of Parish Priest brings with it great responsibilities. Our modern age has imposed organisational burdens on his role which, if he does not share with others will reduce him to a public servant and a bureaucrat, a planner rather than a pastor. The Parish Priest is called to be, above all, a **Shepherd**, a **Pastor and a father**. It is the task of the whole Parish Community to support him in this role.

#### **All Souls Day Mass**


We will have a Mass at St Emilie's on Souls Day **Monday, 2 November at 9.00 am.** May all the Souls of our faithful departed rest in peace!


#### **Catholic Mission Collection**
