Entrance Antiphon:

The Lord became my protector. He brought me out to a place of freedom; he saved me because he delighted in me.

First Reading: A reading from the book of Sirach (27: 4-7)

In a shaken sieve the rubbish is left behind so too the defects of a man appear in his talk. The kiln tests the work of the potter, the test of a man is in his conversation. The orchard where the tree grows is judged on the quality of its fruit, similarly a man's words betray what he feels. Do not praise a man before he has spoken, since this is the test of men.

Responsorial Psalm: (Ps. 91)

R. Lord, it is good to give thanks to you.

- It is good to give thanks to the Lord to make music to your name, O Most High, to proclaim your love in the morning and your truth in the watches of the night. (R)
- The just will flourish like the palm-tree and grow like a Lebanon cedar. (R)

Second Reading: A reading from the first letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians (15:54-58)

When this perishable nature has put on imperishability, and when this mortal nature has put on immortality, then the words of scripture will come true: Death is swallowed up in victory. Death, where is your victory? Death, where is your sting? Now the sting of death is sin, and sin gets its power from the Law. So let us thank God for giving us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Never give in then, my dear brothers, never admit defeat; keep on working at the Lord's work always, knowing that, in the Lord, you cannot labour in vain.

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia, Alleluia! Shine on the world like bright stars; you are offering it the word of life. Alleluia!

Gospel: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke (6:39-45)

Jesus told a parable to his disciples. 'Can one blind man guide another? Surely both will fall into a pit? The disciple is not superior to his teacher; the fully trained disciples will always be like his teacher. Why do you observe the splinter in your brother's eye and never notice the plank in your own? How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me take out the splinter that is in your eye,' when you cannot see the plank in your own? Hypocrite! Take the plank out of your own eye first, and then you will see clearly enough to take out the splinter that is in your brother's eye. 'There is no sound tree that produces rotten fruit, nor again a rotten tree that produces sound fruit. For every tree can be told by its own fruit; people do not pick figs from thorns, nor gather grapes from brambles. A good man draws what is good from the store of goodness in his heart; a bad man draws what is bad from the store of badness. For a man's words flow out of what fills his heart.

PASTORAL CORNER

In the Gospel today, Jesus reminds us that, just as we can recognise a peach tree because of the fruit that grows on it, people will recognise us as followers of Jesus by the way we live our lives, by the things we say and the things we do. If it is the heart that determines the fruit that a person bears, it is with the heart we must listen, meditate and treasure the Word of God. Lectio Divina is an ancient form of prayer with the scriptures that helps us do just that. Below is a short outline of how to practice this way of praying. During this week take todays Gospel or another favourite piece of scripture and meditate on it using the following method.

Read the scripture slowly. Watch for a key phrase or word that jumps out at you or promises to have special meaning for you. Reflect on the word or phrase. Respond to what you have read, and form a prayer that expresses your response, then pray it to God. Let the text soak into your deepest being, savouring an encounter with God. Finally ask God to show you how to live out what you have experienced.
