**Entrance Antiphon:** Give peace, O Lord, to those who wait for you, that your prophets be found true. Hear the prayers of your servant, and of your people Israel.

#### First Reading Book of Sirach 27:30-28:7

Resentment and anger, these are foul things, and both are found with the sinner. He who exacts vengeance will experience the vengeance of the Lord, who keeps strict account of sin. Forgive your neighbour the hurt he does you, and when you pray, your sins will be forgiven. If a man nurses anger against another, can he then demand compassion from the Lord? Showing no pity for a man like himself, can he then plead for his own sins? Remember the last things, and stop hating, remember dissolution and death, and live by the commandments. Remember the commandments, and do not bear your neighbour ill-will; remember the covenant of the Most High, and overlook the offence.

**Gospel:** *Matthew 18:21-35* 

Peter went up to Jesus and said, 'Lord, how often must I forgive my brother if he wrongs me? As often as seven times? Jesus answered, 'Not seven, I tell you, but seventy-seven times. 'And so the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who decided to settle his accounts with his servants. When the reckoning began, they brought him a man who owed ten thousand talents; but he had no means of paying, so his master gave orders that he should be sold, together with his wife and children and all his possessions, to meet the debt. 'At this, the servant threw himself down at his master's feet. 'Give me time,' he said, 'and I will pay the whole sum.' And the servant's master felt so sorry for him That he let him go and cancelled the debt. 'Now as this servant went out, he happened to meet a fellow servant who owed him one hundred denarii; and he seized him by the throat and began to throttle him. 'Pay what you owe me,' he said. 'His fellow servant fell at his feet and implored him, saying 'Give me time and I will pay you.' But the other would not agree; on the contrary, he had him thrown into prison till he should pay the debt. 'His fellow servants were deeply distressed when they saw what had happened, and they went to their master and reported the whole affair to him.

## **Safeguarding Child Protection Week**



As to be expected this year's National Child Protection Week is a little different to previous years due to COVID-19. However, it is important we acknowledge the week and consider how we can all play our part in protecting children and vulnerable adults.

This year the theme for Child Protection Week children is *putting the needs of children first*. The Archdiocesan Safeguarding Director Andrea Musulin has drawn on her 30 years' experience in child protection to co-write with Justine O'Malley from the CEWA Child Safe Team the first safeguarding storybook for children aged 4-11 years. This storybook - *God Gave Elizabeth Grace The Right To Feel Safe* provides a meaningful way in which parents, carers and educators can teach children

and young people about personal safety, sensitive subjects and resilience.

It builds upon the popular 'Protecting God's Children' resource produced by the Safeguarding Office in 2017. The storybook has been made possible through the generous support of The Knights of the Southern Cross WA. An electronic version of the book can be viewed now on the Archdiocese Safeguarding Website. (http://safeguarding.perthcatholic.org.au/) Child Protection Week is a time for us all to reflect on the many ways in which we as individuals can play our part in protecting children both within the Catholic Church and our community – we *can* all play our part.

As a SGO at Mater Christi Parish she organised workshops for parents based on a Christian approach to 'Protective Behaviours', called Protecting God's Children'. Let us all welcome Radha into our **Parish Safeguarding Officers Team** and wish her every blessing in her most important role within our Parish Community.


