14 June 2020 Feast of Corpus Christi Year A

Entrance Antiphon: He fed them with the finest wheat and satisfied them with honey from the rock.

First Reading: A reading from the book of Deuteronomy (8:2-3, 14-16)

Moses said to the people: 'Remember how the Lord your God led you for forty years in the wilderness, to humble you, to test you and know your inmost heart – whether you would keep his commandments or not. He humbled you, he made you feel hunger, he fed you with manna which neither you nor your fathers had known, to make you understand that man does not live on bread alone but that man lives on everything that comes from the mouth of the Lord. 'Do not then forget the Lord your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery: who guided you through this vast and dreadful wilderness, a land of fiery serpents, scorpions, thirst; who in this waterless place brought you water from the hardest rock; who in this wilderness fed you with manna that your fathers had not known.'

Responsorial Psalm: (Ps.147) R. Praise the Lord, Jerusalem.

- •O praise the Lord, Jerusalem! Zion, praise your God! He has strengthened the bars of your gates, he has blessed the children within you. (R)
- He established peace on your borders, he feeds you with finest wheat. He sends out his word to the earth and swiftly runs his command. (R)
- He makes his word known to Jacob, to Israel his laws and decrees. He has not dealt thus with other nations; he has not taught them his decrees (R)

Second Reading: A reading from the First Letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians (10:16-17)

The blessing-cup that we bless is a communion with the blood of Christ, and the bread that we break is a communion with the body of Christ. The fact that there is only one loaf means that, though there are many of us, we form a single body because we all have a share in this one loaf.

<u>Gospel Acclamation</u>: Alleluia, alleluia! I am the living bread from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live for ever. Alleluia!

Gospel: A reading from the Gospel According to John (6:51-58)

Jesus said to the Jews: 'I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world.' Then the Jews started arguing with one another: 'How can this man give us his flesh to eat?' they said. Jesus replied: 'I tell you solemnly, if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood you will not have life in you. Anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life, and I shall raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood lives in me and I live in him. As I, who am sent by the living Father, myself draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from me. This is the bread come down from heaven; not like the bread our ancestors ate; they are dead, but anyone who eats this bread will live for ever.'

<u>Memorial Acclamation</u>: Save us, Saviour of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

<u>Communion Antiphon</u>: Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord.

Public Masses resume at St Emilie's

We are pleased to inform you that Public Masses at St Emilie's have now resumed in keeping with the Phase 3 Government Guidelines and the latest Directives from the Archbishop. Please note that due to the restricted church seating capacity and the Social Distancing requirements you will need to register by emailing our Parish Office at stemilie.office@iinet.net.au

During these exceptional times our Masses are currently **6.30pm on Saturday; and on Sunday 7.30am; 9.30am; 3pm and 5pm.**

Also please note that our weekday Masses have also resumed [Tuesday to Friday at 6.00 pm]. On Wednesdays we also have a Morning Mass at 9.00 am except on the First Wednesday of the month the Mass starts at 8.00 am. There is no registration for the weekday Masses.


