**Entrance Antiphon:** Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

#### First Reading: A reading from the Book of Exodus (34:4-6, 8-9)

With the two tablets of stone in his hands, Moses went up the mountain of Sinai in the early morning as the Lord had commanded him. And the Lord descended in the form of a cloud, and Moses stood with him there. He called on the name of the Lord. The Lord passed before him and proclaimed, 'Lord, Lord, a God of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in kindness and faithfulness.' And Moses bowed down to the ground at once and worshipped. 'If I have indeed won your favour, Lord,' he said 'let my Lord come with us, I beg. True, they are a headstrong people, but forgive us our faults and our sins, and adopt us as your heritage.'

#### Second Reading: A reading from the Second Letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians (13:11-13)

Brothers, we wish you happiness; try to grow perfect; help one another. Be united; live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with the holy kiss. All the saints send you greetings. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

**Gospel Acclamation:** Alleluia, alleluia! Glory to the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit: to God who is, who was and who is to come. Alleluia!

Gospel: A reading from the Gospel According to John (3:16-18)

Jesus said to Nicodemus, 'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life. 'For God sent his Son into the world not to condemn the world, but so that through him the world might be saved. 'No one who believes in him will be condemned; but whoever refuses to believe is condemned already, because he has refused to believe in the name of God's only Son.'

Memorial Acclamation: Save us, Saviour of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

<u>Communion Antiphon</u>: Since you are children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son, the Spirit who cries out: Abba, Father.

#### **PASTORAL CORNER**

This Sunday the beautiful blessing Paul gives us in the second reading is worth spending time with: 'May God bless you with his love, and may the Holy Spirit join all your hearts together'. The more traditional version is used as a greeting at the beginning of Mass. Where in your life have you experienced God's love and blessing, and the unity and fellowship of the Trinity in your relationships? For all of us, faith and belief is a continual journey. Reflect on the things that impede this journey for you, and what are the things that encourage your efforts in this journey?

Just as the Trinity is a pattern of community for us, think about your own relationships. Consider the different attributes of God as Father, Son and Spirit. Make an effort to formulate separate prayers to each member of the Trinity, based on these characteristics.



While you are unable to attend Mass and receive Holy Communion you may wish to pray the following prayer:

#### **An Act of Spiritual Communion**

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already here and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

#### **Public Masses resume at St Emilie's**

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to you about the latest WA Government's easing of the COVID-19 restrictions in Phase 3. As we await Archbishop Timothy Costelloe's new Directives with regard to the celebration of public Masses, we need to start preparing as the numbers for each Mass will be limited and there will be a set of protocols that we will be required to comply with.

At St Emilie's we are planning to have 5 Masses on the weekend as of 6 June 2020: 6.30pm on Saturday; and on Sunday 7.30am; 9.30am; 3pm and 5pm. The weekday Mass Times will remain unchanged.

To assist with managing the numbers allowed, we plan to set up Mass groups of up to 200 people seated in 3 separate areas including the 2 verandahs for each Mass. This unfortunately does not allow for the flexibility we have enjoyed in the past.

To assist with the administration of setting up these Mass groups, please RSVP as soon as possible to the Parish Office by email advising —

- which Mass time you would want to register for
- how many people would be in your family group


