First Reading: A reading from the Prophet of Isaiah (50:4-7)

The Lord has given me a disciple's tongue. So that I may know how to reply to the wearied he provides me with speech. Each morning he wakes me to hear, to listen like a disciple. The Lord has opened my ear. For my part, I made no resistance, neither did I turn away. I offered my back to those who struck me, my cheeks to those who tore at my beard; I did not cover my face against insult and spittle. The Lord comes to my help, so that I am untouched by the insults. So, too, I set my face like flint; I know I shall not be shamed.

Responsorial Psalm: (Ps. 21)

R. My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?

- All who see me deride me. They curl their lips, they toss their heads. 'He trusted in the Lord, let him save him; let him release him if this is his friend.' (R)
- Many dogs have surrounded me, a band of the wicked beset me. They tear holes in my hands and my feet. I can count every one of my bones. (R)
- They divide my clothing among them. They cast lots for my robe. O Lord, do not leave me alone, my strength, make haste to help me! (R)
- I will tell of your name to my brethren and praise you where they are assembled. 'You who fear the Lord give him praise; all sons of Jacob, give him glory. Revere him, Israel's sons.' (R)

Second Reading: A reading from the letter of St. Paul to the Philippians (2:6-11)

His state was divine, yet Christ Jesus did not cling to his equality with God but emptied himself to assume the condition of a slave, and became as men are, and being as all men are, he was humbler yet, even accepting death, death on a cross. But God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all other names so that all beings in the heavens, on earth and in the underworld, should bend the knee at the name of Jesus and that every tongue should acclaim Jesus Christ as Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Gospel Acclamation: Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ, king of endless glory! Christ became obedient for us even to death, dying on the cross. Therefore God raised him on high and gave him a name above all other names. Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ, king of endless glory!

Palm Sunday

With Palm Sunday we now enter Holy Week. At the end of the Holy Thursday Mass, we will leave an <u>empty</u> church and go and keep watch with Jesus at the Altar of Repose, which will be open till midnight.

On Good Friday, the water fonts will be empty in preparation for the new waters that will be blessed at the Easter Vigil before the baptism of our 7 Elect. We will start the Easter Vigil with the church in darkness and the doors shut, the priest brings the new light into the darkened church, intoning 'Christ our Light'. It is good to wait till the priest has entered before moving in to find a seat. The Old Testament readings and Psalms remind us of all that God has done for his people. The Liturgy of Baptism will welcome 7 new members into our Christian community and we join them in renewing our own baptismal promises.

Stations of the Cross: Every Friday during Lent after 6pm Mass.

<u>Parking during Holy Week</u> As we expect many to attend the Holy Week Masses and services, from next weekend till Easter Sunday, we will have volunteers to assist with parking. 



