Entrance Antiphon: To you I call; for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words. Guard me as the apple of your eye; in the shadow of your wings protect me.

First Reading: A reading from the prophet Isaiah (53:10-11)

The Lord has been pleased to crush his servant with suffering. If he offers his life in atonement, he shall see his heirs, he shall have a long life and through him what the Lord wishes will be done. His soul's anguish over he shall see the light and be content. By his sufferings shall my servant justify many, taking their faults on himself.

Responsorial Psalm: (Ps.32)

R. Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you

- The word of the Lord is faithful and all his works to be trusted. The Lord loves justice and right and fills the earth with his love. (R)
- The Lord looks on those who revere him, on those who hope in his love, to rescue their souls from death, to keep them alive in famine. (R)
- Our soul is waiting for the Lord The Lord is our help and our shield. May your love be upon us, O Lord, as we place all our hope in you. (R)

Second Reading: A reading from the letter to the Hebrews (4:14-16)

Since in Jesus, the Son of God, we have the supreme high priest who has gone through to the highest heaven, we must never let go of the faith that we have professed. For it is not as if we had a high priest who was incapable of feeling our weaknesses with us; but we have one who has been tempted in every way that we are, though he is without sin. Let us be confident then, in approaching the throne of grace, that we shall have mercy from him and find grace when we are in need of help.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! The Son of Man came to serve and to give his life as a ransom for all! Alleluia!

Gospel: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark (10:35-45)

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, approached Jesus 'Master,' they said to him, 'we want you to do us a favour.' He said to them, 'What is it you want me to do for you?' They said to him, 'Allow us to sit one at your right hand and the other at your left in your glory.' 'You do not know what you are asking' Jesus said to them. 'Can you drink the cup that I must drink, or be baptised with the baptism with which I must be baptised?' They replied, 'We can.' Jesus said to them, 'The cup that I must drink you shall drink, and with the baptism with which I must be baptised you shall be baptised, but as for the seats at my right hand or my left, these are not mine to grant; they belong to those to whom they have been allotted.' When the other ten heard this they began to feel indignant with James and John.

<u>The Memorial Acclamation:</u> We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection until you come again.

PASTORAL CORNER

Jesus model for leadership is that of a Servant King. In this week's Gospel he is faced with a question of power, and the exercise of authority. He is put in a spot by a question from James and John the sons of Zebedee. Jesus tells them it is not in his power to decide who will be in God's Kingdom and says whoever seeks power among us should look to serve the others and whoever seeks first place..... "must be the servant of all".

We are not to look for rewards in terms of position, power and status in this life, rather we look to the example of Jesus the Messiah and Saviour who came as a servant, the slave of all. This is the challenge presented by Jesus to those who would follow him. How practical is the model of servant leadership for the Church, and for us? What difference might this model


