Entrance Antiphon Come you blessed of my Father, I was hungry and you gave me to eat, I was a stranger and you took me in, I was sick and you visited me.

First Reading From the Acts of the Apostles (6:1-7a)

Now during those days, when the disciples were increasing in number, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution of food.

And the twelve called together the whole community of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should neglect the word of God in order to wait on tables. Therefore, friends, select from among yourselves seven men of good standing, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may appoint to this task, while we, for our part, will devote ourselves to prayer and to serving the word."

What they said pleased the whole community, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, together with Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch. They had these men stand before the apostles, who prayed and laid their hands on them. The word of God continued to spread; the number of the disciples increased greatly in Jerusalem.

Gospel John (15:9-17)

Jesus said to his disciples: 'As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my own joy may be in you and your joy be complete. This is my commandment: Love one another as I have loved you. A man can have no greater love than to lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends, if you do what I command you. I shall not call you servants any more, because a servant does not know his master's business; I call you friends because I have made known to you everything I have learnt from my Father. You did not choose me, no, I chose you; and I commissioned you to go out and bear fruit, fruit that will last; and then the Father will give you anything you ask him in my name. What I command you is to love one another.'

Pastoral Corner



We are all called to be God's messengers -spreading the news of the Kingdom of God and continuing the work of his apostles in true discipleship. What better example could we follow than that of our Patron Saint, St Emilie de Vialar, whose Feast day we celebrate this weekend. St Emilie reached out to all in love, regardless of religion, race or colour, so as to reveal the infinite love of the Father.

This week think about inviting someone to share a meal with you, especially someone who might not otherwise have some company. Like St Emilie de Vialar, be conscious of being life-giving to others, by showing love, acceptance and understanding to all.



St. Emilie de Vialar

Anne Marguerite Adelaide Emilie De Vialar was born in Gaillac France into a noble and wealthy family on 12 September 1797 during the turmoil of the French Revolution. It was a time of great persecution for the Church. At Christmas of 1832 Emilie left her family home and acquired a house that would serve the needs of the poor and the sick. She would soon become the Foundress of the Institute of

the Sisters of St Joseph of the Apparition and her provisional Rule of Life was approved by the Archbishop of Albi. In 1833 Sr Emilie was able to open a new convent, schools, women's refuges and hospitals in the muslim nations of Algeria and Tunisia. In spite of the many trials and challenges that she had to face, her mission continued to thrive and expand. Soon the Sisters of St Joseph of the Apparition were established in Cyprus and then Malta. In January 1855 at the invitation of Bishop Serra of Perth the Sisters left London for Western Australia. They reached Fremantle on 24 May 1855 on the Feast of Our Lady Help of Christians. On 20 August 1856 she was taken ill and after receiving the last rites she passed away peacefully at the age of 58. She was beatified on 18 June 1939 and later canonised on 24 June 1951. *"Now I was overflowing with love for God and filled with strength to avoid every offence against Him."* *"Towards God I have the trust and simplicity of a child but, aware of my duties, I am no less eager to accomplish them."*




