

First Reading From the Book of the prophet Amos (7:12-15)

Amaziah, the priest of Bethel, said to Amos, 'Go away, seer; get back to the land of Judah; earn your bread there, do your prophesying there. We want no more prophesying in Bethel; this is the royal sanctuary, the national temple.' 'I was no prophet, neither did I belong to any of the brotherhoods of prophets.' Amos replied to Amaziah, 'I was a shepherd and looked after sycamores: but it was the Lord who took me from herding the flock, and the Lord who said, "Go, prophesy to my people Israel".'

Responsorial Psalm Ps. 84

R. Lord, show us your mercy and love, and grant us your salvation.

- I will hear what the Lord God as to say, a voice that speaks of peace, peace for his people. His help is near for those who fear him and his glory will dwell in our land. (R)
- Mercy and faithfulness have met; justice and peace have embraced. Faithfulness shall spring from the earth and justice look down from heaven. (R)
- The Lord will make us prosper and our earth shall yield its fruit. Justice shall march before him and peace shall follow his steps. (R)

Second Reading A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Ephesians (1:3-14)

Blessed be God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with all the spiritual blessings of heaven in Christ. Before the world was made, he chose us, chose us in Christ, to be holy and spotless, and to live through love in his presence, determined that we should become his adopted sons, through Jesus Christ for his own kind purposes, to make us praise the glory of his grace, his free gift to us in the Beloved in whom, through his blood, we gain our freedom, the forgiveness of our sins. Such is the richness of the grace which he has showered on us in all wisdom and insight. He has let us know the mystery of his purpose, the hidden plan he so kindly made in Christ from the beginning to act upon when the times had run their course to the end: that he would bring everything together under Christ, as head, everything in the heavens and everything on earth. And it is in him that we were claimed as God's own, chosen from the beginning, under the predetermined plan of the one who guides all things as he decides by his own will; chosen to be, for his greater glory, the people who would put their hopes in Christ before he came. Now you too, in him, have heard the message of the truth and the good news of your salvation, and have believed it: and you have been stamped with the seal of the Holy Spirit of the Promise, the pledge of our inheritance which brings freedom for those whom God has taken for his own, to make his glory praised.

Gospel Acclamation *Alleluia, alleluia!* May the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ enlighten the eyes of our heart that we might see how great the hope to which we are called is. *Alleluia!*

Gospel Mark (6:7-13)

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out in pairs giving them authority over the unclean spirits. And he instructed them to take nothing for the journey except a staff - no bread, no haversack, no coppers for their purses. They were to wear sandals, but, he added, 'Do not take a spare tunic.' And he said to them, 'If you enter a house anywhere, stay there until you leave the district. And if any place does not welcome you and people refuse to listen to you, as you walk away shake the dust from under your feet as a sign to them.' So they set out to preach repentance; and they cast out many devils, and anointed many sick people with oil and cured them.

We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection until you come again.

Communion antiphon The sparrow finds a home, and the swallow a nest for her young; by your altars, O Lord of hosts, my King and my God. Blessed are they who dwell in your house, for ever singing your praise.

Pastoral Corner

In this week's Gospel, the Apostles are to leave behind all their possessions, and are not to rely on their own resources but on the authority that had been given them by God and the kindness of those they meet on their way. It is the same for us. Being that vulnerable makes the message the real resource, they, like us and Amos, have to rely on the power and authority given to us all.

When we are free of the importance of possessions, place and people, then we are free to work for the Lord. Only then can we have our minds on the job of living the Christian life and bringing others to Christ. We have but to live simply, trust in Jesus and spread Jesus' message of the Good News. This week, reflect on how you might be able to live like that, and what an example that would be to others.




