Entrance Antiphon

1st Reading

Jonah (3:1-5, 10)

The word of the Lord was addressed to Jonah: 'Up!' he said. Go to Nineveh, the great city, and preach to them as I told you to.' Jonah set out and went to Nineveh in obedience to the word of the Lord. Now Nineveh was a city great bevond compare: it took three days to cross it. Jonah went on into the city, making a day's journey. He preached in these words, 'Only forty days more and Nineveh is going to be destroyed.' And the people of Nineveh believed in God; they proclaimed a fast and put on sackcloth from the greatest to the least. God saw their efforts to renounce their evil behaviour. And God relented: he did not inflict on them the disaster which he had threatened.

And Jesus said to them, 'Follow me and I will make you into fishers of men.' And at once they left their nets and followed him. Going on a little further, he saw James, son of Zebedee and his brother John, they too were in their boat, mending their nets, he called them at once, and leaving their father Zebedee in the boat with the men he employed, they went after him.

In this week's Gospel we hear how Jesus chose fishermen to be his disciples and told them that he would teach them how to bring in people instead of fish. They had to leave everything behind to follow him. Their new role was to catch people for Christ. How can we, as followers of Christ, do this too?

Preaching, teaching and healing comprised the ministry of Jesus, and it is this ministry that we are being asked to share. In what way do you most clearly hear the voice of Jesus? What exactly does the voice of Jesus call you to do and ask you to leave, to follow him? What makes leaving these things worthwhile?

Commitment Masses for 2024 Sacramental Program




