Entrance Antiphon: The Lord is the strength of his people, a saving refuge for the one he has anointed. Save your people, Lord, and bless your heritage, and govern them for ever.

First Reading: A reading from the Book of Job (38:1, 8-11)

From the heart of the tempest the Lord gave Job his answer. He said: Who pent up the sea behind closed doors when it leapt tumultuous out of the womb, when I wrapped it in a robe of mist and made black clouds its swaddling bands; when I marked the bounds it was not to cross and made it fast with a bolted gate? Come thus far, I said, and no father; here your proud waves shall break.

Responsorial Psalm: (Ps. 106)

R. Give thanks to the Lord, his love is everlasting. (R.)

- Some sailed to the sea in ships to trade on the mighty waters. These men have seen the Lord's deeds, the wonders he does in the deep. (R.)
- For he spoke; he summoned the gale, tossing the waves of the sea up to heaven and back into the deep; their soul melted away in their distress. (R.)
- Then they cried to the Lord in their need and he rescued them from their distress. He stilled the storm to a whisper: all the waves of the sea were hushed. (R.)
- They rejoiced because of the calm and he led them to the haven they desired. Let them thank the Lord for his love, the wonders he does for men. (R.)

Second Reading: A reading from the second letter of St Paul to the Corinthians (5:14-17)

The love of Christ overwhelms us when we reflect that if one man has died for all, then all men should be dead; and the reason he died for all

was so that living men should live no longer for themselves, but for him who died and was raised to life for them. From now onwards, therefore,

we do not judge anyone by the standards of the flesh. Even if we did once know Christ in the flesh, that is not how we know him now. And for anyone who is in Christ, there is a new creation. The old creation has gone, and now the new one is here.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! A great prophet has appeared among us; God has visited his people. Alleluia!

Gospel: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark (4:35-41)

With the coming of evening, Jesus said to his disciples, 'Let us cross over to the other side.' And leaving the crowd behind they took him, just as he was, in the boat; and there were other boats with him. Then it began to blow a gale and the waves were breaking into the boat so that it was almost swamped. But he was in the stern, his head on a cushion, asleep. They woke him and said to him, 'Master, do you not care?' We are going to drown!' And he woke up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, 'Quiet now! Be calm!' And the wind dropped, and all was calm again. Then he said to them, 'Why are you so frightened? How is it that you have no faith?' They were filled with awe and said to one another, 'Who can this be? Even the wind and the sea obey him.'.

Memorial Acclamation: Save us, Saviour of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

Communion Antiphon: The eyes of all look to you, Lord, and you give them their food in due season.

Pastoral Corner


In this week's Gospel, the disciples awaken Jesus with an accusation – master don't you care we are going to drown!! After calming the sea and their fear, Jesus rebukes them for their great fear and small amount of faith; it is then that the question arises "Who then is this Man?"

What kind of a person is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him. Often in life we will find that when we have invited Jesus into our boat – into our life- we don't get so thrown by all the stormy things that happen to us along the way. However, if we panic too much, we can't always hear Jesus helping us to weather the storm and calm down a bit. Then we realise that with God in charge we don't actually need to be so terrified! This week reflect on the ways that Jesus has helped you to weather your storms in the past and spend some time in prayer to strengthen your connection to him.


