

Pastoral Corner

In this week's readings, the nature of our Saviour is explored in the letter to the Hebrews. Rather than being a High Priest in the old sense Jesus became fully human. Being fully human he became subject to the same temptations that assail each of us, yet he did not sin. Jesus has now become our advocate, to whom we can draw near in time of need as we would to our closest friend. Jesus in the Gospel is faced with a question of power and the exercise of authority, and he explains it is not in his power to decide who will do what in God's Kingdom nor should we seek power. He then tells the disciples that we "must be servant to all" and goes on to say we are not to look for rewards in terms of position, power and status in this life. Rather we should look to the example of Jesus the Messiah and Saviour who came as a servant, the slave of all. This is the challenge presented by Jesus to those who would follow him. To be a servant. Jesus gave his life for others by dying and by the way he lived.

This week find time to reflect on the message of the Gospel and think about how you can be like Jesus in your own way and in the way you live.






